Guidelines for Scholarship Awards

1. All Recipients

- a. All scholarship recipients must sign a letter of intent stating that they will work in Rock or Green counties upon graduation from the program.
- b. All scholarship recipients must sign a letter of intent committing to volunteer service in a hospice care or equivalent approved setting prior to graduation.
- c. All scholarship recipients must be in good academic standing and enrolled in the nursing program at BTC.
- d. Scholarship amounts will be determined on a need basis, up to \$1,000 for first year nursing students and up to \$1,500 for second year nursing students.
- e. Scholarships will be applied to the student's account after all other grants and scholarships have been applied.
- f. Scholarships are to be used for tuition only.
- g. Scholarships will be awarded annually in the fall semester and distributed 50% in the fall and 50% in the spring, predicated on the successful completion of the previous semester with a 2.5 GPA or better.
- h. All Scholarship recipients will be identified as Nancy B. Parker Nursing Scholars.

2. Year Two Recipients

- a. All scholarships in year two will be based on merit.
- b. Prior to applying for the year-two scholarship, applicants will have completed 50 hours of volunteer service in senior healthcare programs and shall evidence same by a letter from the facility identifying the student by name, the student’s participation, the number of hours volunteered and the type of work or service performed.
- c. Year two scholarship recipients will have a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- d. Year two scholarship recipients will have inquired and applied to three different jobs within the nursing field before they are eligible to receive their second semester distribution. Written notification of the application recipients will be given to BTC together with a contact phone number to be used to verify that the complete application was received.

Statement of Commitment to remain in Rock or Green Counties
