

Student Representative to the Board

The District Board shall recognize an ex-officio, non-voting student representative for the Blackhawk Technical College District Board to serve as a liaison between the Board and the student body in the interest of furthering communications, and to provide input for the formulation and review of policies concerning student life and services. The following terms and conditions shall apply to the appointment.

- The student representative shall serve a one-year term beginning June 1 and expiring May 31. The Student Government Association (SGA) will conduct elections in the month of May for the position.
- The representative must be a second-year student and must maintain a 2.5 grade point average.
- The student shall not vote on matters brought before the Board, shall not attend closed sessions of the Board, and shall not participate in Board deliberations unless called upon to provide information.
- The student representative shall receive the posted regular monthly Board meeting agenda and minutes of regular Board meetings.
- A place on the agenda shall be provided for the student representative to report on activities or concerns.
- The SGA shall make provisions for an alternate in the event the designated student representative can no longer serve.
