

DUTIES OF BOARD MEMBERS

B-221

The duties, obligations and responsibilities of an individual Board Member shall be as follows:

1. To promote student learning.
2. To be familiar with state laws concerning technical education, regulations of the Wisconsin Technical College System and the Blackhawk Technical College District policies, rules and procedures.
3. To have a knowledge of the educational philosophy, and the mission, goals and objectives of the Blackhawk Technical College District.
4. To work harmoniously with other Board members.
5. To vote and act in the Board meetings impartially for the good of the District.
6. To accept the will of the majority vote in all cases and support the resulting action.
7. To promote the interest of and support for the College.
8. To refer complaints to the President/District Director and to abstain from individual counsel and action.
9. To prepare for full Board and committee meetings by reviewing agenda material prior to meetings.
10. To participate, when possible, in committee meetings.
