

## BOARD MEMBERS

Members of the Board should endeavor to attend all meetings, be prepared to discuss items presented on the agenda, to suggest other items for consideration, and to vote upon motions and resolutions presented.

Official Board decisions shall be made during duly constituted meetings. Individual Board members or groups of Board members do not have independent authority to speak for or act on behalf of the Board and should make no out-of-meeting commitments unless directed to do so on behalf of the Board.

It is important that Board members be nonpartisan in dealing with school matters and not subordinate the education of youth and adults to any partisan principle, group interest, or personal ambition.

In addition to the foregoing, Board members should meet the following qualifications:

1. They should have personal integrity, intelligence, and appreciation of the values of technical education.
2. They should be citizens willing and capable of assuming responsibility.
3. They should have the ability to work with others, should have the courage of their convictions, should always vote their beliefs, and should be champions of technical education.
4. They should be prepared and willing to devote a sufficient amount of time to the study of the issues of education in the Blackhawk Technical College District as well as the state and nation.
5. Board members will have no business financial interests that will conflict with the decisions of the Board.
