

NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION

The Board Chair and President/District Director shall assist each new member-elect to understand the Board's functions, policies and procedures. The following suggested methods shall be employed.

1. The new Board member shall be given selective material relating to technical education, to Blackhawk Technical College, and to the Wisconsin Technical College District Boards Association.
2. The new Board member shall be invited to attend Board meetings and participate in discussion prior to being seated.
3. The President/District Director shall supply the new Board member with material pertinent to Board meetings, with an explanation on its use.
4. The new Board member shall be invited to meet with the President/District Director, Board Chair and other appropriate school personnel to discuss services they perform for the Board.
5. The new Board member shall be provided information on how to access Board Policies electronically and a copy of the Wisconsin Statutes relating to technical education by the President/District Director.
6. New Board members will be assigned a current Board member to serve as a mentor.
