Survey Procedures: The following summary information was compiled from a survey of the 2016-2017 graduating class conducted six months after graduation. Multiple contacts and methods were employed to reach all available graduates for their participation, and to insure the highest rate of validity for this study. The following summary provides information on job placement, employment status, and salaries of students. The data are dependent on the amount of information returned by each graduate.
