



COVID-19 Community Testing Site at Blackhawk Technical College

What

FREE COVID-19 testing

This is a drive-thru testing site. Anyone getting tested must remain in the vehicle. A nasal swab will be used to collect a sample by a uniformed member of the Wisconsin National Guard. Up to 650 tests will be administered per testing day.

Who

Testing is open to anyone age five and older. Individuals experiencing symptoms are encouraged to get tested. COVID-19 symptoms include:

cough, fatigue, sudden loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, fever, muscle pain, nausea or vomiting, chills, headache, diarrhea

Additional Information

- No appointment is necessary, though pre-registration is recommended.

- Registration will not be accepted more than 72 hours in advance of testing.
