What

FREE COVID-19 testing

This is a drive-up testing site. Please stay in the vehicle until it is your turn. Individuals will be notified when it is their turn and will walk-in to the testing area. A nasal swab will be used to collect a sample by a member of the Wisconsin National Guard.

Please note that once supplies have been exhausted for the day, it may necessitate an early closure of the testing site. Testing site hours of operation are subject to change.

Who

Testing is open to anyone 12 months of age and older. Individuals experiencing symptoms are encouraged to get tested. COVID-19 symptoms include:

cough, fatigue, sudden loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, fever, muscle pain, nausea or vomiting, chills, headache, diarrhea

- No appointment is necessary, though pre-registration is recommended.

- Registration will not be accepted more than 72 hours in advance of testing.
